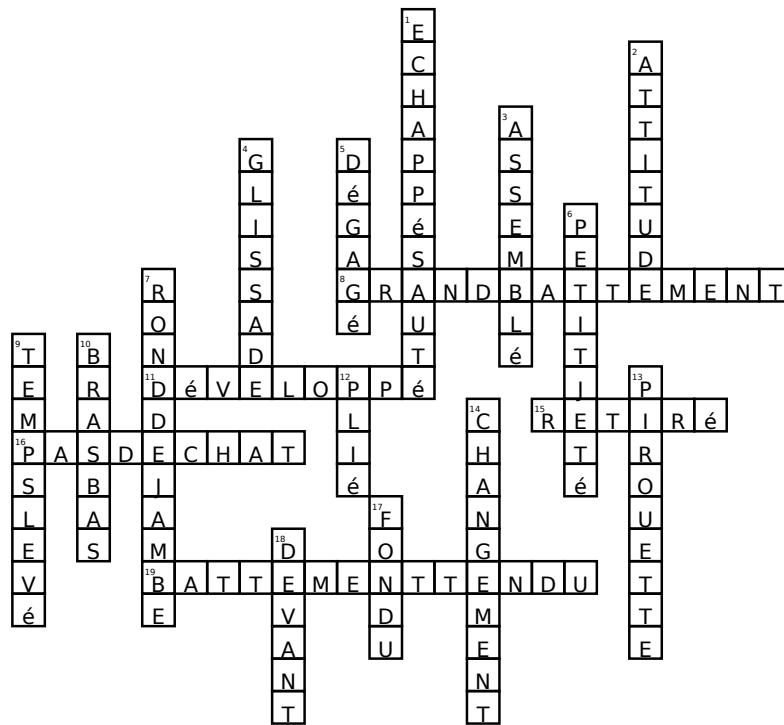


Ballet Steps Cross word



Down:

1. a jump from a closed position to an open position and back.
2. a contained position based on curves. A pose on one leg with the other leg held in a curved position off the floor, the Arms are in 4th position.
3. it means to assemble.
4. a transferring step where the action starts in a demi-plié, the working leg extends to the floor in fondu, the supporting leg then pushes away from the floor and is released so that both legs are momentarily fully stretched, the transfer continues, lowering through the leading foot into fondu and the freed foot closes form a dégagé into a strong demi-plié.
5. a step where you stretch one foot out pointed to the floor
6. a small spring on the spot from one foot to the other, landing with the foot placed at the ankle.
7. a step where you make circles with your leg

Across:

8. a strong throwing action of a straight leg into the air through a battement tendu on the way up and down.
11. a slow sustained unfolding action of the working leg.
15. a drawing up action of the working foot to "retiré" position (the knee)
16. the step of the cat
19. a step where you stretch one foot out pointed to the floor and close
